Job Summary: The intern will work closely with the Education Director, and on occasion the Executive Director or Garden Manager on educational programming, special events and other tasks. Duties will include helping to plan and run preschool programs, homeschool programs, monthly special events, six weeks of an art/nature summer camp, planning and curriculum design, clerical duties, and visitor studies. Working with your university to establish the possibility for college credit is an option. Applicants must have a strong interest in science, good communication skills and the ability to work with people of all ages.

Requirements: Applicants must be current or recent university students. Primary study areas could include education, recreation, interpretation, environmental science, biology, etc. Internship dates are flexible but must include the weeks of summer camp. Interns must commit to a 6 week minimum, with no maximum; and a 10 hour/week minimum with a 40 hour/week maximum. Position can include some weekends and possible evenings. The intern must be self-directed, able to work well with others and alone, have good organizational skills and efficiency. Public speaking skills and customer service ability is needed. Free on-site housing is available; a security deposit is required and linens and kitchenware are the responsibility of the intern.
