Position Summary: The Day Camp Specialist provides support to the Environmental Education Coordinator and DeVries staff. Primary responsibilities include developing and delivering environmental education programs, administrative duties, and animal care. This position is temporary, part-time, starting in May and ending in August.

Hours: The Day Camp Specialist can expect to work 35-40 hours a week Monday-Friday. Some evening and weekend work may be required.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist Education Coordinator in creating, promoting, and delivering Nature Day Camp programs.
- Assist Education Coordinator in planning and teaching field trips to K-12 school groups.
- Supervise school-aged children during 10 weeks of Summer Nature Camps.
- Keep education materials organized and maintain inventory of materials.
- Care for live education animals (snakes, turtles, hissing cockroaches, chickens), as well as nature center exhibit room.
- Assist with public events.
- Provide visitor services tasks such as greeting visitors, providing information, and answering phone calls.
- Other duties assigned by the Education Coordinator/Executive Director.

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 18 years of age and pass a comprehensive background check.
- Must have the ability to create and deliver environmental education lessons.
- Experience working with and/or supervising school-aged children in an outdoor or group setting.
- Must be able to work independently on projects and deadlines.
- Flexibility, attention to detail, and energetic nature.

- Knowledge of computer programs such as Microsoft and Google Suite.
- Must be willing to work outdoors in all weather conditions and be able to perform medium to heavy physical labor.
- Must be willing to work a flexible schedule, including some evenings and weekends.
- Must be current on CPR/First Aid certification or willing to obtain certification.
